

- President John F. Kennedy proposes Trade Adjustment Assistance under 1962 Trade Expansion Act
- Amendments
 - Trade Act of 1974
 - Trade Adjustment Assistance Reform Act of 2002
 - Established TAAF
- · American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009
 - Reauthorized and modified TAAF
 - · Added certain classes of Fishermen
 - · Added specific outcomes
 - · Clarified eligibility and reporting
 - · Intent purpose of the ARRA to stimulate the economy




TAAF Appropriations

- Congressional appropriation for TAAF was \$220 million
 - \$90 M for 2009 and 2010, \$40 M for 2011
- Due to the time required for rule making and public notification, no commodities were approved in 2009 and \$65 Million of the 2009 appropriation was not expended

Concluding thoughts

- The financial assistance cash payment was more than a simple transfer payment due to TAA training and producer reported investments in business operations and employment.
- Overcame numerous challenges: distance, language, education, different backgrounds, initial apprehension, consultants need to establish initial rapport with clients, etc.
