
The Dairy industry is among the Largest operation for Ag. Commodities in many Western states (Farm Receipts).

It is the 2nd largest for Arizona, Colorado, Utah and Washington.




Dairy Farm Receipts 2017 – in Millions of Dollars


Dairy Farm Receipts 2012 - 2017 in Millions of Dollars






Dairy Farm Receipts 2012 - 2017 in Millions of Dollars (excludes California)










































Dairy Cost of Production by State



Dairy Cost Of Production By Herd Size






Cost of Production: Median & Percentiles


ROA by States: 2014 - 2018

ROA by States: 2015 - 2018



Average ROA by Herd Size (WI, MI & NY)







